Notice of Tentative Determination and Public Hearing

In accordance with Sections 1-601, 1-602, 1-604, and 9-209 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has made a Tentative Determination to approve a Refuse Disposal Permit Application submitted by Prince George's County Department of the Environment for the proposed Area C Landfill to be constructed between the existing Area A and Area B of the Brown Station Road Landfill located at 3500 Brown Station Road in Upper Marlboro, Maryland. Brown Station Road Sanitary Landfill is a non-hazardous solid waste acceptance facility that accepts residential and commercial waste (household refuse and waste from businesses), scrap automobile and truck tires, and construction and demolition debris for disposal and/or recycling.

A Public Hearing is scheduled for Thursday, April 13, 2023 at 5:30 pm at the Arrowhead Elementary School Multi-Purpose Room located at 2300 Sansbury Road, Upper Marlboro, Maryland 20774. The Public Hearing will be held to provide the citizens an opportunity to formally comment on MDE's Tentative Determination concerning the proposed landfill. Public Informational Meetings concerning this application were previously held on December 17, 2019 at the Arrowhead Elementary School.

Upon prior request, MDE will provide an interpreter for the deaf or hearing-impaired persons. The permit application, supporting documents, and draft permit will be available for public review at the Largo-Kettering Branch of the Prince George's County Memorial Library System located at 9601 Capital Lane, Upper Marlboro, Maryland 20774 and at MDE by appointment after March 22, 2023 and on the MDE website: <https://mde.maryland.gov/programs/LAND/SolidWaste/Pages/index.aspx>.
