☑ Environmentally Preferable Products and Services

We have replaced plastic products with compostable, edible pasta substitutes:

- We use fettuccine for our coffee stirrers
- We use long, uncut ziti for our beverage straws
- We use birch utensils instead of plastic
- **Environmental Restoration and Community Environmental Projects**

We work with McDaniel College clubs (Green Life) and fraternities (Sigma Alpha Epsilon) to organize community clean-up and Earth Day events. This provides community service opportunities for these organizations and benefits our city.

✓ Recycling

We recycle 100% of our cardboard and our flexible plastic waste. This has reduced our annual solid waste contribution by more than 8 tons.

✓ Composting

We work with local farms to compost our eggshells, green waste and coffee grounds.

Energy

✓ Energy Efficiency

- We have converted 100% of our lighting to LED.
- We use a programmable thermostat to load shed and schedule our lighting and HVAC energy usage.

Water

✓ Water Conservation

We installed momentary/activated faucets in our restroom to conserve water usage.
