Annual Environmental Goals

We plan to create a living wall by planting American Grape and other native plants on an existing fence to attract pollinators, reduce noise, and create visual appeal for our club. We are also replacing our HVAC system with more efficient equipment.

Environmentally Preferable Purchasing

BSR purchases Energy Star, LED and energy efficient products.

\checkmark **Energy Efficiency**

In the summer of 2022, BSR replaced all incandescent interior lighting with LEDs, saving 20% in operating costs. We are also installing a Mitsubishi energy efficient split HVAC system.

Water

\checkmark **Stormwater Management**

BSR has a dedicated landscaping and groundskeeping partner that ensures that plantings, landscaping, and chemical use is environmentally safe and used minimally.
