- Example of 100% diversion capacity

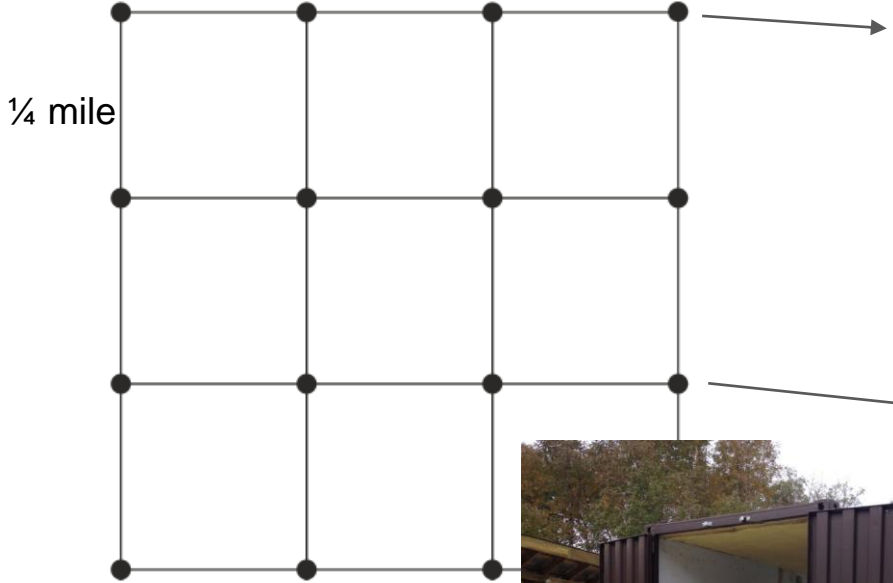

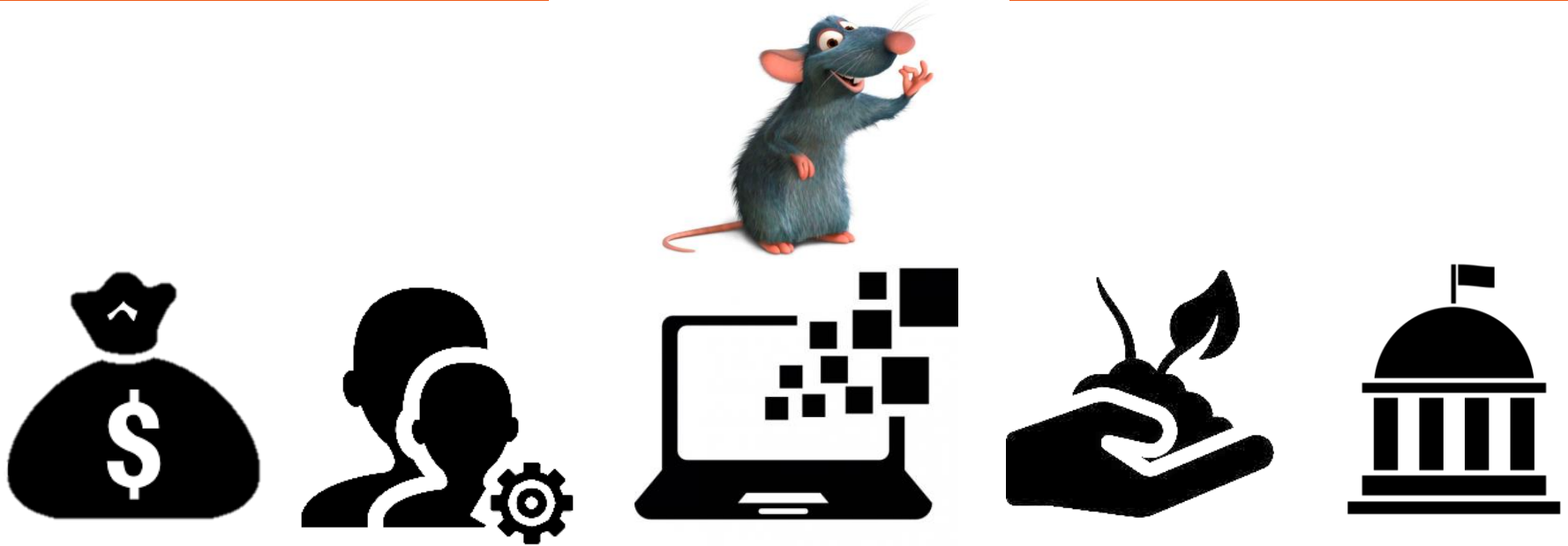

Manage Carbon, Leverage More Opportunities

- Carbon Life-Cycle Management
 - Weeds out green washing from what's truly effective
 - Make a key decision criteria
- Opportunity to address a cross-section of issues, equity
 - Address structural inequities between communities
 - Subsidize all composting approaches, not just one
- On-site composting meets MD's 30 mile radius to require source separating
- Size ≠ Scale
