## 2009 TAWES AWARD FOR A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT and The James B. Coulter Award

The Maryland Department of the Environment and the Maryland Petroleum Council have announced that nominations are now being accepted for the 2009 Tawes Award for A Clean Environment.

In 1976 the first winner of the Tawes award was announced at the Tawes Crab and Clam Bake in Crisfield, Maryland. Now sponsored by the Maryland Department of Environment and the Maryland Petroleum Council, this unique environmental recognition program is named after the late Governor J. Millard Tawes (1959-1967), who was the first secretary of the Natural Resources Department.

**SCOPE OF THE AWARDS:** Includes community clean-ups, school ecology or beautification projects, recycling, prevention and control of hazardous materials, waste reduction, or other innovative environmental enhancement ideas or projects.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:** Open to any individual, civic, community, non-profit or business entity that has demonstrated outstanding efforts to enhance Maryland's environment - either for a single project or over a period of time.

**AWARDS:** Winners and their guests will be honored at an Awards luncheon in Annapolis. A donation will be made to the recipient's favorite nonprofit organization. They will also receive a handsome engraved plaque. Awards will be presented in the following categories:

- 1. Youth (under the age of 21)
- 2. Adult or Organization.
- 3. Government Employee.

recognizes a government employee who
goes above and beyond his/her duties in
