Administrative Costs Incurred by Local Governments

Status Report

Purpose: Section 4, Chapter 428, Acts 2004 under Annotated Code of Maryland, Chapter 9, Section 1605.2 of Environment Article requires that on or before December 31, 2006, the Bay Restoration Fund (BRF) Advisory Committee, in conjunction with the Maryland Association of Counties and Maryland Municipal League shall provide a report to the Governor and the General Assembly regarding the extent of administrative costs incurred by local governments in collection of the Bay restoration fee and the reasonableness of the reimbursement authorized by the statute.

The Bay Restoration Fund legislation allows local billing authorities reimbursement for reasonable administrative costs in an amount not to exceed 5% of the total fee collected. The local billing authorities are allowed to carry forward any unreimbursed expenses and claim them against future fee deposits on a cumulative basis.

The table below shows a summary of the administrative expenses claimed by the local billing authorities since the inception January 1, 2005 through billing period ending September 30, 2006. The details by County are provided in Appendix A.

As expected, the above data shows that except for the initial startup costs, the incremental administrative costs incurred by local billing authorities was expected to drop over time. The administrative costs as a % of total fee collected have continued to drop with every subsequent billing cycle from 5.4% initially (first six months 1/2005 - 6/2005) to 0.44% for the most recent quarter (07/2006 - 09/2006). In the future, the administrative costs claims by local billing authorities are expected to be less than 0.50% of fees collected.

Conclusion: Based on the above, the administrative cost allowance of up to 5% of fees collected, as provided by the Bay Restoration Fund statute, is more than reasonable.
