Perryville, Cecil County, Maryland.

DESCRIPTION OF CERTIFIED PROJECT: Regulated activities associated with construction of roads, parking lots, retaining walls, and stormwater management facilities for two warehouse distribution facilities within Site C of the Principio Business Park (Site C-1/200,000 square feet, Site C-2/598,500 square feet). The project permanently impacts 43,319 square feet of forested nontidal wetland, 4,538 square feet of isolated forested nontidal wetland, 94,796 square feet of the nontidal 25-foot buffer, 1,723 linear feet (15,442 square feet) of a Use I intermittent stream (Northeast Creek), and 29,757 square feet within the 100-year nontidal floodplain of Principio Creek 2 (Use III). The site is located on Principio Parkway East, which is south of the CSX Railway and north of Pulaski Highway (US Route 40), in Perryville, Cecil County, Maryland.

CONDITIONS OF THIS CERTIFICATION INCLUDING THE NWP REGIONAL PERMIT CONDITIONS AND NWP GENERAL PERMIT CONDITIONS.
